Primary Focus Areas

- |||| Maximize readiness from point of injury through return to duty with the management, treatment, and rehabilitation of neuromusculoskeletal injuries
- |||| Manage battlefield, acute and chronic pain
- |||| Optimize burn injury repair—regenerate aesthetic subunits and reduce donor site morbidity
- |||| Regenerate neuromusculoskeletal tissues (nerve, muscle, cartilage, vasculature, bone) to restore structure and function after injury
- |||| Fully restore function to service members with limb amputation or trauma using assistive technologies and rehabilitation methods
- |||| Manage ocular injuries from point of injury through return to duty
- |||| Restore vision and ocular structures after injury
- |||| Develop treatments to repair and restore hearing, tinnitus, and balance disorders
- |||| Develop assessments and rehabilitation strategies for cognitive and neurosensory dysfunction after mild Traumatic Brain Injury (mTBI)
